




Stable Falciparum malaria






# 3 HEALTH DETERMINANTS




# ADB NEEDS ASSESSMENT: SCOPE OF AN HIA









#### Definition of health

•• Embeds a consistent definition of health in ADB documents

#### Communicable Diseases in Poverty and Social Analysis

••Clarifies meaning of communicable diseases

#### Introduction to HIA

••Describes basic concepts of HIA for use in ADB procedures

#### Malaria in Infrastructure Development

- ••Supports decisions:
  - ••Is malaria a concern?
  - ••Can project design contribute to malaria management?

#### Advocacy for HIA

••Convinces staff why HIA is needed


#### Sector specific screening and classifying for health

- ••Helps decide the health classification of projects at the concept stage
- ••Tools are available for the sectors: transport, energy, water and urban




# TOOLS FOR DEVELOPING MEMBER COUNTRIES

# EXAMPLE: TRANSPORT SECTOR -HEALTH IMPACTS

#### Active travel

- ••Promotes healthy weight for urban communities
- ••Reduces air pollution
- ••Reduces congestion

#### Air quality

- ••Is a cause of many diseases
- ••Kills people at very low concentrations

#### Road traffic injury

- ••Epidemic
- ••Affects the poor disproportionally

#### Noise

••Affects mental and spiritual well-being

#### Severance

- ••Reduces community cohesion
- ··Creates barriers to active travel
