
Urban Expressway Authority's Challenge for Dissemination of EVs in Japan? (Paper #33 Poster #34)

Summary: Hanshin Expressway Co. Ltd. (HEC), an urban expressway authority in the Kansai metropolitan region of Japan, has launched a car sharing project with electric vehicles (EVs). Dissemination of EVs is expected to solve tangled issues (e.g., traffic congestion, CO2 emission and finance of the highway authority); in other words, it would certainly contribute to building a sustainable urban expressway business model for HEC.
