The Insomnia



- Demands for paisagistic conformity from UNESCO;
- Many Vineyard operations had to be supervised by national environmental authorities which had to be consulted for authority approval:
 - Institute of Nature Conservation and Biodiversity
 - · Commission of North Region Development
 - · Administration of North Hydrographic Region

Time and Money Consuming...





The Investments



Selection of vineyards plantation areas, leaving aside for biodiversity protection areas around the small nesting cliff, defining a Nesting protection area;

Keep old olives and bushes, allowing a higher level of habitat mix (not only vineyards);

Implementing vegetation stripes bordering vineyards;



The Investments



Delay vineyards plantation schedule (less perturbation and slower habitat change);

Keep water streams and its natural vegetation stripes (working as small ecological corridors and avoiding soil erosion);

Monitoring birdlife communities to assess changes due to project implementation;

Conservation Plan for the Black-wheatear (*Oenanthe leucura*), known as Port wine bird, a critically endangered species, which became one of the project icons;



The Investments



Plantation of small native woodlands;

Placement of food and drinking troughs to support fauna.

Construction of narrow terraces, each of which supporting only a single row of vines;

Keep traditional schist walls;

Let spontaneos vegetation growth bettwen rows and edges;



The Results

The project didn't had a negative significant impact on Biodiversity (Birds), in some cases improved it;

What is it?


- Initiative of the European Commission which aims business to integrate






Looking Further...


- Setting up a <u>financial guaranty</u> to enable refunding if certain environmental damages have origin on their activity, regarding to soil, water and biodiversity values;
