



Mogalakwena Mine "Second economy"

Sustainable mine closure best demonstrated at Mogalakwena mine:

- Usual rehabilitation activities PLUS focus on sustainable development
- Creating a "**second economy**": financial injection during operational phase to the surrounding communities that *supports sustainable practices* that will last beyond closure.

How:


- Social and Labour Plan (SLP) projects,

Intent - Working with stakeholders towards sustainable post closure during life of mine.






Sustainable Development System






Regional Master Plan

"Regional Master Plan provides **interactive relationship between projects** to streamline and coordinate land stewardship and community development initiatives."




