Thank you for submitting your abstract for presentation at IAIA15, "Impact Assessment in the Digital Era," to be held 20-23 April 2015 in Florence, Italy.

Confirmation of your presentation on the final schedule is contingent upon receipt in IAIA Headquarters (HQ) of the presenting author's registration and full payment of fees before 16 January 2015. You must attend and present the paper at the conference in order to be included in the program and proceedings.

The preliminary program, including registration materials, is posted online (http://conferences.iaia.org/2015/preliminary_program.php). Registration is open from 10 November. The registrar at HQ will provide confirmation when your registration and fees have been received and processed.

Presenting authors are required to register and pay fees by 15 January 2015. At that time, your presentation will be dropped from the program if you are not yet registered with fees paid in full. If you have extenuating circumstances which would require later payment, please contact jen@iaia.org to make arrangements prior to 15 January.

Please note that IAIA does not have funds available to pay registration and/or travel expenses for program participants.

Substitutions for presenting authors may be made until 16 January. The substitute must be registered for the conference at the time of the substitution. The substitute will be listed as the presenting author in conference materials. Co-authors may be added until 16 January. These changes may be made via your dashboard.

No changes to the title or text of your submission will be accepted during or following the review period (after 28 November).

You will receive final confirmation of your place on the program as well as specific details and information about your session between 9-13 March (contingent upon your registration and payment of fees by 16 January). Please note that individual requests for specific presentation dates and/or times cannot be addressed due to the very large number of presentations and other factors that the program committee must consider when scheduling the overall program.

You are encouraged to prepare a paper for review, but the submission of a paper is optional. A designated review coordinator (Loreley Fortuny, IAIA HQ) will arrange for two independent and anonymous reviews. Papers deemed acceptable by this process will be included in the conference proceedings on the IAIA website. If you submit a paper for peer review, you and/or your co-authors will be asked to conduct a review as well.

Papers must be no longer than five pages in length or 2,000 words, of which a minimum of 1,200 words must be written in English and the remaining 800 words may be done in the language of your choice. References are additional, which may bring the total page limit to 6 pages; this limit is strictly applied. Papers should be no more than 1 MB in size (to minimize e-mailing problems), prepared in Word with the file name in this format: Abstract submission ID number_Primary author's family name_First Four Words of Title, and sent to impact@iaia.org by 14 February 2015. Reviews will be completed and comments sent back to you by 20 March. Revisions, if applicable, will be due 26 June. Please note that you must be registered, with fees paid, by 16 January and you must make your presentation at the conference in order to have your paper published in the online proceedings.

Current plans are to post completed papers online before the conference and for them to inform preparations for on-site discussions. Please do not hesitate to request guidance regarding the paper submission and review process from Loreley (impact@iaia.org).
