Presenting author registration

Confirmation of your poster on the final program is contingent upon receipt in IAIA Headquarters (HQ) of the presenting author's registration and full payment of fees before 5 February 2016. If you have extenuating circumstances which would require later payment, please contact info@iaia.org prior to 5 February to make arrangements. As of 6 February, your presentation will be dropped from the program if you are not yet registered with fees paid in full and have not contacted IAIA to make other arrangements. You must attend and present the poster at the conference in order to be included in the program and proceedings.

The preliminary program, including registration materials, is posted online (<http://conferences.iaia.org/2016/program.php>). Registration is open from 1 November. The registrar at HQ will provide confirmation when your registration and fees have been received and processed.

Please note that IAIA does not have funds available to pay registration and/or travel expenses for program participants.

Presenting author substitutions

Substitutions for presenting authors may be made until 5 February. The substitute must be registered for the conference at the time of the substitution, must be an original co-author, must not exceed the two-sessions-per person rule, and will be listed as the presenting author in conference materials. Please contact jen@iaia.org with the presenting author's name; the substitute's name, e-mail address, organization, country, and short (30-word maximum) bio; and the abstract name and number.

No other changes to your submission are accepted after 30 November.

Poster preparation

As you prepare the technical content of your poster, please make every effort to relate it to the conference theme. Preparation details such as dimensions of the poster board will be provided to you in January. Tips on poster preparation are available at <http://conferences.iaia.org/2016/say-it-with-a-poster.php>.

Notification of presentation time

You will receive final confirmation of your place on the program as well as the time and date and other information about the poster session between 1-8 April (contingent upon your registration and payment of fees by 16 January).

Papers/Online proceedings

The submission of a paper on the subject of your poster is optional, but strongly encouraged. The intent is to post draft papers before the conference to inform preparations for on-site discussions, and to post final papers following the conference so that you can incorporate suggestions from delegates in your final version, which will be included in the online conference proceedings.

A review coordinator (Loreley Fortuny, IAIA HQ) will arrange for two independent and anonymous reviews. Papers deemed acceptable by this process will be included in the conference proceedings on the IAIA website. If you submit a paper for review, you and/or your co-authors will be asked to conduct a review as well.

Papers must be no longer than 2,000 words (approximately five pages in length), of which a minimum of 1,200 words must be written in English and the remaining 800 words may be done in the language of your choice. References are additional, which may bring the total word limit to 2,500 words; this limit is strictly applied. Papers should be no more than 1 MB in size (to minimize e-mailing problems); prepared in MS Word with the file name in this format: Abstract submission ID number_Primary author's family name_First Four Words of Title; and sent to impact@iaia.org by 29 February 2016. Reviews will be completed and comments sent back to you after that date. Revisions, if applicable, will be due 26 June. Please note that you must be registered, with fees paid, by 5 February and you must make your presentation at the conference in order to have your paper published in the online proceedings.
