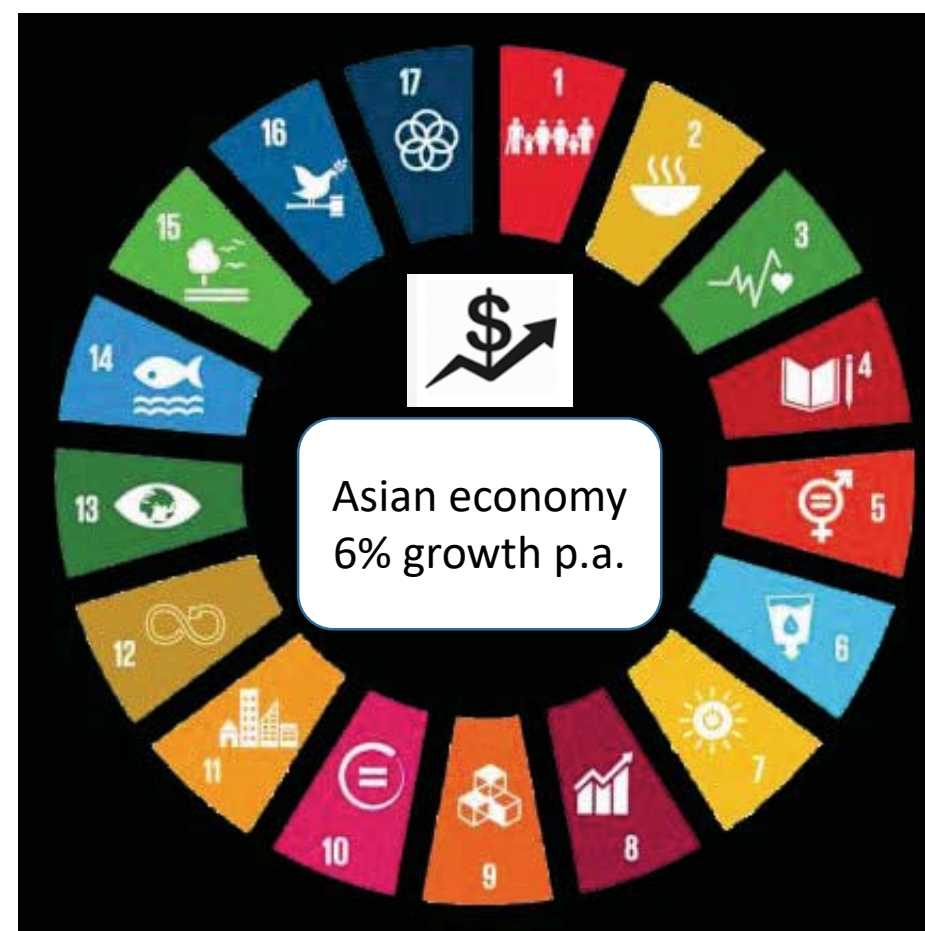
Growing inequality in Asia from 1990 to 2013 prevented 165 million people from escaping extreme poverty
