#### Presenting author registration

Confirmation of your presentation on the final schedule is contingent upon receipt in IAIA Headquarters (HQ) of the presenting author's registration and full payment of fees before 4 February 2021 (no exceptions). As of 5 February, your presentation will be dropped from the program if you are not yet registered with fees paid in full. If the event is held in person in Seville, you must attend and present in person at the conference in order to be included in the program and proceedings.

Please note that IAIA does not have funds available to pay registration and/or travel expenses for program participants.

#### **Presenting author substitutions**

Substitutions for presenting authors may be made until 4 February. The substitute must be registered for the conference by 4 Fenbruary, must be an original co-author, must not exceed the one-session-per person rule, and will be listed as the presenting author in conference materials. Please contact jen@iaia.org with the presenting author's name; the substitute's name, e-mail address, organization, country, and short (30-word maximum) bio; and the abstract name and number.

No other changes to your submission are accepted after 4 February 2021.

# Notification of presentation time

You will receive final confirmation of your place on the program as well as specific details and information about your session between 14-16 April 2021 (contingent upon your registration and payment of fees by 4 February).

Please note that individual requests for specific presentation dates and/or times for an in-person conference cannot be addressed due to the very large number of presentations and other factors that the program committee must consider when scheduling the overall program.

# Papers/Online proceedings

The submission of a paper is optional, but strongly encouraged. The intent is to post draft papers before the conference to inform preparations for conference discussions, and to post final papers following the conference so that you can incorporate suggestions from delegates in your final version, which will be included in the online conference proceedings.

Papers must be no longer than 2,000 words (approximately five pages in length), of which a minimum of 1,200 words must be written in English and the remaining 800 words may be done in the language of your choice. References are additional, which may bring the total word limit to 2,500 words; this limit is strictly applied. Papers should be no more than 1 MB in size and prepared in MS Word with the file name in this format: Abstract submission ID number\_Primary author's family name\_First Four Words of Title. Until 14 May, draft papers can be uploaded to <a href="https://conferences.iaia.org/2021/submit-draft-paper.php">https://conferences.iaia.org/2021/submit-draft-paper.php</a>. Final papers should be uploaded to <a href="https://conferences.iaia.org/2021/submit-edited-paper.php">https://conferences.iaia.org/2021/submit-edited-paper.php</a> between 15 May and 30 Jun. Please note that you must be registered, with fees paid, by 4 February and you must make your presentation in order to have your paper published in the online proceedings.
