Vancouver Fraser Port Authority enables Canada's trade

- Federal agency that stewards the Port of Vancouver, Canada's largest port
- Facilitates Canada's trade through the port, ensuring safety, environmental protection, and consideration for communities
- Complex jurisdiction
- Borders 16 municipalities
- Intersects traditional territories and treaty lands of several Coast Salish First Nations
- Proud to have relationship agreements with Musqueam Indian Band and Tsawwassen First Nation

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Working together to advance Roberts Bank Terminal 2: port authority and Musqueam's three shared goals

1. Effectively reduce and offset the effects of Roberts Bank Terminal 2 in a manner that ensures meaningful involvement of Musqueam in planning and implementation
2. Integrate knowledge, input, and priorities of Musqueam into Roberts Bank Terminal 2 and its components
3. Ensure alignment with long term stewardship objectives of both Musqueam and the port authority

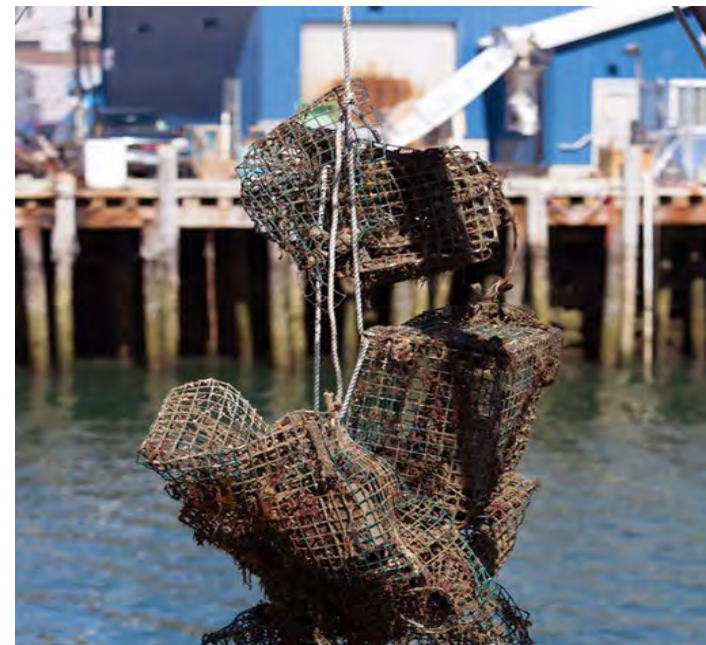
