SUSTAINABILITY - IA THEME



Assessment matters (section 24 of the BC Environmental Assessment Act, 2018) require that the integration of information across disciplines, particularly the assessment of the effects on biophysical factors that support ecosystem function and of the **effects on current and future generations**.





GENDER BASED ANALYSIS + (GBA+) – IA THEME




Under section 25 of the BC Environmental Assessment Act, 2018, the following matters must be assessed in every EA...:

Disproportionate effects on distinct human populations including populations identified by gender.





